Sealed Proposals will be received by the Municipality of Penn Hills through PennBid until **10:30 a.m. prevailing time on Thursday, November 30, 2021** for the following project:

LONG ROAD PIER REPAIR PROJECT

GENERAL CONTRACT – LONG ROAD PIER REPAIR PROJECT

This project involves the re-building of an existing stone masonry pier at the intersection of Long Road and Joan Drive in Municipality of Penn Hills.

All Proposals must be submitted electronically via Penn Bid, (www.PennBid.net), before **10:30 a.m. prevailing time, on Thursday, November 30, 2021.**

Proposals shall be delivered in a sealed envelope and clearly marked on the outside with the words "**LONG ROAD PIER REPAIR PROJECT**".

Copies of Drawings, Specifications, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Forms of Proposals, Agreement and other documents related to this solicitation are available at no cost on the Pennbid site (www.PennBid.net).

DAVIS BACON Wage Rates are required to be paid on this project.

There will be a non-mandatory pre-bid meeting on November 18, 2021 at 11:00 A.M. at the project site location.

Proposals must be submitted on the forms provided by the Municipality of Penn Hills. Proposals to receive consideration must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder's Bond from a Surety Company authorized to do business in Pennsylvania, made to the order of the Municipality of Penn Hills in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the Proposal as a guarantee that, if the Proposal is accepted, the successful Bidder will enter into an Agreement within 15 days after Notice of the Award of the Contract.

The Proposals must be made to the Municipality of Penn Hills, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and shall remain firm for a period of ninety (90) days. No Bidder may withdraw his Proposal during the ninety (90) day period without forfeiting his Bid guarantee.

Performance, Maintenance, and Labor and Material Payment Bonds, along with Public Liability and Property Damage Certificates of Insurance in the amounts specified, as well as Certificates of Workman's Compensation must be filed with the executed Agreement upon acceptance of the Proposal from the successful Bidder.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals, or any part thereof, for any reason, and also reserves the right to waive any informality therein.
