

The Municipality of Penn Hills - Water Pollution Control Department is seeking full-time Laborers to train in wastewater operations and maintenance and prepare to become certified by the PA Department of Environmental Protection as a certified Wastewater Operator. **Applicant must possess HS diploma or GED equivalent and a valid PA Driver's License, CDL is required within 6 months of hire.** Trade school or college course work desirable. Prefer experience in the main/repair of wastewater equipment, sewer line, plumbing, electrical, mechanical or any other equivalent combination of education and training which provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities.

Paid training is available to successful laborer applicant to help them obtain a PA DEP Class B, E Subclass 1 Wastewater Certification. Once certification is obtained, employee will have the opportunity to advance to Wastewater Operator when positions are available.

The current Laborer pay rate is \$21.1095/hour (\$20.3595/hour during 6-month probationary period) and includes health, dental, and vision coverage, life insurance and PTO package.
